Tom Cunningham is vice president and associate director of research for the Federal Reserve Bank of Atlanta. Prior to his appointment as associate director of research he served as vice president in the research department where he has been responsible for the Regional, Latin American and Finance research teams. Dr. Cunningham joined the Bank as an economist with the macropolicy group in 1985, specializing in macroeconomics and monetary theory. He was promoted to senior economist in 1989 and research officer and senior economist with responsibility for the regional group in 1992. Dr. Cunningham previously worked as an instructor of economics at Barnard College at Columbia University.

A native of Reedley California, he received a bachelor's degree, summa cum laude, in economics from California State University, Fresno. He earned a master's degree, a master of philosophy and a doctorate of philosophy in economics from Columbia University.
